

The City of Delta, will receive sealed bids at the City of Delta City Hall Building, [360 Main Street, Delta, Colorado](#), for the West 1st Street and North Palmer Street project until 1:00 P.M. on March 27, 2018. Bids will be opened in public.

This project generally consists of replacing rebuilding the intersection area of West 1st Street and North Palmer Street in the City of Delta, including the removal of approximately 2,700 Square yards of concrete and asphalt pavement, 328 feet of 18-inch storm sewer piping, concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk replacement, 2,600 square yards of roadway reconstruction, and 2,400 square yards of asphalt pavement. All work will be managed under the direction of the City of Delta Public Works Department or their designated representative.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting is required for all prime contractors wanting to submit a bid for the project. The pre-bid meeting will be held at 1:00 PM at the intersection area of West 1st Street and North Palmer Avenue in Delta, Colorado on Monday, March 19, 2018.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest qualified bidder, as determined by the statement of qualifications and the bid, which is deemed to be in the best interest of the City. The City reserves the right to accept the bid by a competent bidder that will result in the lowest cost to the City. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid without disclosing the reason therefore. No bids may be withdrawn after the opening of bids, without consent of City of Delta, for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of opening of bids. The successful bidder or bidders will be required to furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds equal to the full amount of each bid or proposal if the bid exceeds \$50,000 as outlined in the contract.

All bids must be submitted in writing on the forms provided and must be signed by the bidder or his duly authorized agent.
