

The Delta City Council has submitted a question to the voters in the City of Delta regarding a 1/2% increase in Sales and Use Taxes for the Parks, Recreation and Golf departments. The City Council would like to clarify the purpose of the question on November 6, 2018 election ballot.

The following is information regarding the ballot question:

- The City of Delta has not increased sales tax in 27 years.
- Operation and maintenance funds for golf course would not be coming out of utility funds after January 1, 2019.
- The tax would be for the operations and maintenance at the golf course.
- Tax would allow for Parks services to continue and Master Plan to be completed.
- Tax would allow for Recreation services to continue as are now being done.
- The tax on goods sold in Delta would increase from 3% to 3.5%

City of Delta Referred Measure 2B

SHALL THE CITY OF DELTA'S REVENUE BE INCREASED BY AN ESTIMATED \$1,000,000.00 ANNUALLY (FIRST FISCAL YEAR INCREASE), AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, BY INCREASING THE CITY'S EXISTING SALES AND USE TAX RATES FROM THREE PERCENT (3%) TO THREE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (3.5%), WITH SAID INCREASE TO BEGIN ON JANUARY 1, 2019, AND END ON DECEMBER 31, 2029, PROVIDED THAT THE REVENUES FROM SAID TAX INCREASE SHALL BE USED FOR PARKS, GOLF AND RECREATION PURPOSES, AND SHALL ALL SUCH TAX REVENUES BE COLLECTED, RETAINED, AND SPENT AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20, OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY REVENUE OR EXPENDITURE LIMITATIONS CONTAINED IN THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR OTHER APPLICABLE LAW?
